<b>What is the Role of DAC?</b>	<p>The purpose of the DAC was shared as part of the presentation/slide show. The DAC serves in an advisory capacity to the school district regarding the development of the Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) and to serve as a communication link between the schools and communities, which constitute the school district.</p> <p>DAC is comprised of various stakeholders including parents, teachers, school staff, and administrators.</p>
<b>Learning Continuity &amp; Attendance Plan (LCAP)</b>	<p>The LCAP draft was sent to participants of the DAC prior to the meeting for review. The LCAP was also reviewed at the meeting and feedback/input solicited.</p> <p>Input included clarification about the range of minutes listed for synchronous and asynchronous learning. There was feedback provided for the re-engagement plan or tiers/supports to explicitly add the referral to counselors in Tier I.</p> <p>The LCAP draft was updated based on this feedback.</p>
